WHAT ENVIRONMENT IS THIS SUITED TO?

Caatinga stylo mix is well suited to a wide range of tropical and subtropical environments with summer dominant rainfall where average annual rainfall is greater than 550mm. Caatinga stylo mix has a greater tolerance to frost than some other stylo types.

WHAT ABOUT THE SOIL TYPE?

Caatinga stylo mix is suited to a wide range of soil types, often being recommended for planting on clay loams to heavy cracking clays, where many of the other stylos are not suited. Caatinga stylo mix is not suited to seasonal flooding or flood plain zones (water logged areas). Caatinga stylo mix prefers fertile soils, however, has shown persistence in medium – low fertility soils.

AND THE ESTABLISHMENT?

Establishing Caatinga stylo mix can be challenging. For ease of establishment there are two recommended strategies:

- Seeding in strips or bands within the existing pastures where interplant competition has been reduced.
- Sowing Caatinga stylo mix first and then adding grasses in the second year to overcome competition from vigorous grasses.

The Envirogro Seed Treatment Process decreases seed dormancy and increases early plant germination. Inoculation is critical for the Caatinga stylo mix as it requires specific inoculum.
